



In our case, we are linked to schools in the United Kingdom (London), Hungary (Budapest) and Turkey (Samsun), to work on the SKILLS that we believe are basic to face the challenges of 21st century society:

- Communication



In each mobility, we have met in different places to address issues that are common to all of us, regardless of our origin, nationality, religion or culture. Thus, in Samsun (Turkey) we learned the value of defending human rights; in Palma, we met to talk about climate change and the different possible solutions to stop it, building active, reactive and creative consciences; while in London (United Kingdom) we addressed the problem of substance abuse, and the prevention of the risks involved, especially for young people of all nationalities.
